The University of Dubuque has been on the semester calendar except for the period September 1946 - June 1949, when the quarter system was in effect.

ACADEMIC STATUS

A student is in good standing for a given semester unless there is an adjoining note which says "Academic Suspension", "Academic Probation", "Readmitted on Probation", or "Continued on Probation".

CREDITS FOR GRADUATION

Prior to January 1964, 120 semester hours were required for a bachelor's degree, but no credit was allowed for physical education courses. For students graduating after January 1964 and before December 1994, the number of credits required for graduation was typically 124 semester hours for a bachelor's degree or 64 semester hours for an associate degree. The Tri-College Adult Degree Program required 120 semester hours for a bachelor's degree or 60 semester hours for an associate degree. Beginning December 1994, only 120 semester hours are required for a bachelor's degree or 60 semester hours for an associate degree.

COURSE NUMBERS

As of Fall 1986, the course numbering system was changed to designate course levels as follows: 001-099, pre-college; 100-199, freshman; 200-299, sophomore; 300-399, junior; 400-499, senior; 500-699, graduate. Prior to that time, freshman courses were numbered 1-49, sophomore courses 50-99, and junior/senior courses 100-199.

CAMPUS CODES

Due to frequent cross-registering among the institutions comprising the Tri-College Cooperative Effort, a campus code appears in front of each course number to indicate whether the course was taken at the University of Dubuque (D), Clarke University (C), or Loras College (L). Courses are numbered according to the system in effect at each campus.
